MINUTES OF THE ARTS, PUBLICITY AND FUNDRAISING COMMITTEE

**3. Minutes of the Arts, Publicity and Fundraising Committee Meeting held on 1 June 2011**

It was proposed by Councillor Mrs. Galbraith, seconded by Councillor T. Galbraith and agreed unanimously that the minutes of the meeting held on 1 June 2011 be signed as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

**4. Petuaria Press**

As Duncan could not attend the meeting due to holidays, he submitted a lengthy list of stories and details of competitions to be included in the next issue (No. 46) of the Petuaria Press. This is due to be delivered on 23 September.

**5. 2011 Open Day and Literacy Competition**

It was reported that the Open Day had been a resounding success with an excellent response from all who attended. Unfortunately the literary competition had been poorly supported and only 7 entries had been received. In view of this it was agreed not to hold the competition again.

**6. Art & Photography Exhibition – 21, 22, 23 October 2011**

Preparations for the exhibition are now in hand. Mike Clark has ordered 3 x banners to display prior to the event and advertising posters have been printed and displayed. Articles are to be placed in the ERYC Parish News throughout September and October and notices are to be sent to the Hull Daily Mail and Radio Humberside. 70 businesses have been approached within the parish to sponsor the event and also trophies for six categories. The closing date for sponsors is the 30th September and to date five out of the six trophies are taken and six businesses have sponsored the event. Crystal glass trophies have been sourced and it was agreed that these be purchased. Once the details for the engraving work is to hand, this can be carried out. Councillor Mrs. Brogden is to devise a list of volunteers for the event.

**7. Police Band Concert - 3 December 2011**

It was agreed to keep the price of tickets at £5.00 and a set of four tickets will be available to win in the next issue of the Petuaria Press competition. Advertising for the concert will start during September and tickets will be on sale as from October.
